Greg Goddard has had shoulder surgery, and will be unable to attend this year. Rob Shelor will be attending in Goddard's place and will be Toby Hyke's partner. My partner, Michael Moser, is also having shoulder and neck issues and will be unable to attend. Andy Neely will be taking Michael's place this year. We welcome Andy Neely and Rob Shelor to their first Golf Trip, and welcome Tracy Thompson back for another year.

I will be handling the daily team competition (First, Second and Third), and the 4-day tournament (First, Second, Third and Fourth). The entry fee is still a paltry \$125 per player. Please bring your entry fee to the Calcutta.
